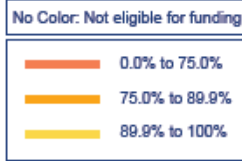

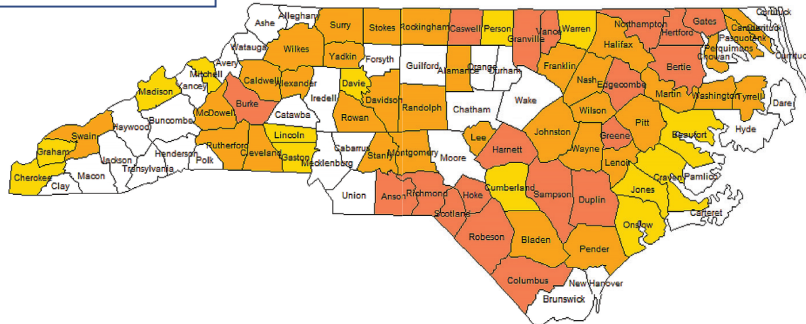
In 2019, 125 North Carolina schools visited Tryon Palace, of them, 18 were Title 1 schools.

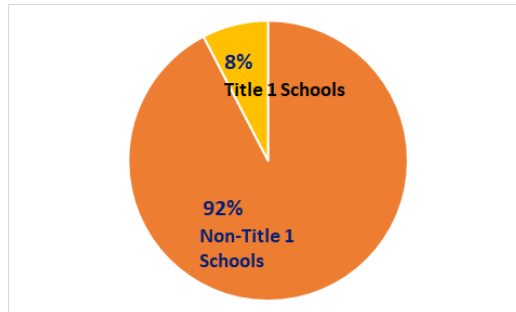
Total of NC schools

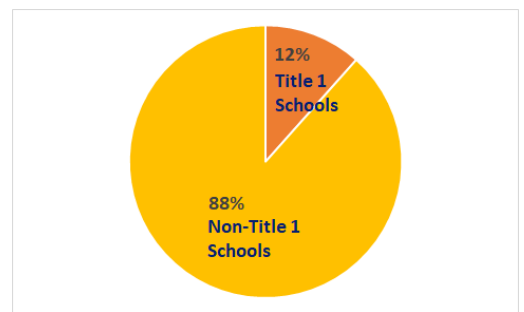
Total of NC Title 1 Schools

## LETS DO THE MATH

Bus: approximately \$2.80 / mile\*

Admissions to Tryon Palace, the North Carolina History Center, and historic gardens: \$8 + tax / student

Chaperone: \$15 + tax for additional chaperone

Substitute Teacher: \$103 per school day\*

For a field trip for a class of 23 students with 3 chaperones (two are included in the group sales), coming from Raleigh (260 miles away), the totals would be:

Bus: approximately \$1,456 round trip  
 Admissions: \$196.42  
 Additional Chaperone: \$16.01  
 Substitute Teacher: \$103  
 Approximate total cost: \$1,771.43
